

## ***St. Peter's School Revised COVID Protocols, February 22nd, 2022***

**As of February 28th, 2022 STP will move to a MASK-OPTIONAL policy  
(Mask-Optional does not mean Mask-Free)  
Masks are still recommended to mitigate the spread of COVID**

### **Return to Mask Wearing if:**

- more than 5% of the student population is COVID positive, the whole school will mask for at least 5 days. If the positive percentage remains at or above 5%, school-wide masking will remain in effect until less than 5% student population is positive.
- 2 or more positive students in a classroom, entire classroom will mask for 5 days.

### **Masks Required:**

- At all school mass
- When grade levels intermingle
- While singing in music class
- On buses
- On field trips

**Contact Tracing** will remain the same. You will be notified by the School Nurse if your student is a close contact.

**Students should have 1-2 masks in their backpack at all times.**

### **Rapid Antigen and PCR testing will continue to be available at school:**

- Any student who has more than 1 symptom will be required to get tested before returning to school.
- Any student deemed a close contact will be asked to wear a mask for 5 days followed by a PCR test. If a PCR test is not performed, student will be asked to mask for 10 days.
- Test to Stay may be an option as determined by the administration.

### **Mask Supervision is not possible.**

While we support the parental option of mask-wearing or non-wearing, school teachers and staff will not be able to supervise specific family choices.

Please make your wishes known to your children.

***Keep students home when experiencing symptoms.***

***Continue to report all positive cases and close contacts.***
